These foster, adoptive and kinship families rely on FAFS to improve their experience with care by providing superlative resources and support like the New Jersey Foster Care Scholars Program, which offers eligible foster and homeless youth assistance with tuition fees at public colleges, universities and vocational schools.

FAFS' Self Esteem Dreams Initiative, made possible with funding from the Dreams R Us Foundation and gracious donor support, gives children who are, or have been, in foster care in New Jersey the opportunity to enjoy experiences that enrich their lives.

The currently underway annual Holiday Toy Drive gives children in foster care the opportunity to benefit from a holiday season complete with the warmth, welcoming and care every child deserves year-round.
