Community Education + In-Service Training Hours

As a caregiver, you need to meet the state's in-service training requirements in order to stay licensed, but you don't want to waste time on courses that aren't relevant to your needs. embrella offers numerous training opportunities, so you can choose the topics that will be most helpful to you and your family. By attending our community workshops, or taking our webinars, e-learning courses, or home correspondence courses, you'll gain valuable information that will help you become a more confident and skilled caregiver, even in the most stressful situations. Some of our most popular courses are:

COMMUNITY WORKSHOPS/WEBINARS ►

Resource Parents and Youth Can Attend Court: Secure an understanding of New Jersey legislation and how it affects resource caregivers and youth attending court hearings such as the family's permanency hearing.

Understanding and Supporting Adolescents in Care: Discuss issues that arise for adolescents in care as they relate to education, employment, housing stability, culture and community life, transportation, health care and life skills as well as gain strategies to help you support and mentor the adolescent in your care.

Visitation: A Path to Healing: Gain skills to assist in preparing, aiding, and addressing concerns while also gaining techniques for handling concerns that may arise when a child has their family time.

E-LEARNING COURSES ►

Child Safety Essentials I & II: Learn how to keep children safe whether indoors or outdoors by learning risk factors that children may face in and outside of the home.

Affirming & Inclusive Love: Embracing LGBTQI+: Gain an enhanced understanding of the LGBTQI+ community and our youth who identify in one or more of these groups.

The Multicultural Family I & II: Know how to handle challenges that arise when caring for a child or youth of a different race or culture while also gaining skills to manage awkward or intrusive questions.

HOME CORRESPONDENCE COURSES ►

Balancing Love and Loyalty: Learn about the connection between boundaries and kinship care and identify strategies to help set and maintain healthy boundaries as you adjust to your new role as a kinship caregiver.

Teaming with Birth Families for Success: Gain skills in building positive working relationships with families and learn tips for working with reluctant families and helping children transition home.

Understanding Trauma & Resilience I & II: Increase your awareness of trauma by learning its themes, while obtaining strength-driven approaches that are geared to support children and youth in building a resilient mindset.

Connecting Families meetings give you the chance to share your experiences, challenges, and successes as a caregiver in a safe and supportive environment. Programs for Children + Youth

Our programs for children and youth who are, or were, in care promote feelings of belonging and boost their self-esteem, allowing them to grow into happier, more self-sufficient adults.

She has an amazing gift with the horses and has become confident and in control when she is with them... Fostering Wishes helps caregivers pay for the little extras that are a big deal to their kids. Funds are used to pay for school yearbooks, senior class rings, prom tickets, art or music lessons, camp registrations, scouting expenses, and much more. DREAMERS AND BELIEVERS ►

Dreamers and Believers provides enrichment experiences for children and youth (up to age 21), who are, or were, in care. Young people can choose to pursue their dream based on exceptional skill, ability, or interest. Dreams granted include horseback riding camp, dance lessons, sports training, and more. Private Scholarship + Opportunity Grants

It's a common misconception that young people who are, or were, in care attend college for free. Unfortunately, this is not the case, so it's best to prepare early. embrella's programs for adolescents can help.

embrella offers academic scholarships & opportunity grants for high school seniors who are, or were, in care. These awards help these students with expenses associated with attending college or technical school or living on their own. That we won't amount to anything in life, or that we don't have what it takes to go to college, due to personal family backgrounds, or just history. But it's very heartwarming to know you see us, and you see right through the challenges and obstacles we had to take on to get where we are now.

Other programs embrella offers for adolescents include:

NEW JERSEY FOSTER CARE (NJFC) SCHOLARS PROGRAM ▶

NJFC provides funding for eligible youth who have experienced a CP&P out-of-home placement, CP&P independent living arrangement or transitional living program and are seeking a post-secondary degree at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university, or a career/technical school. PATHWAYS TO ACADEMIC + CAREER EXPLORATION TO SUCCESS (PACES) ▶

PACES serves NJFC Scholar-eligible adolescents between the ages of 16-21 as they transition out of high school in the following counties: Hunterdon, Middlesex, Somerset, Mercer, Monmouth, and Ocean. This referral-based program offers coaching in soft skill development and decision-making processes, researching and utilizing community resources, applying for jobs and colleges, completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and much more.
