Tiered Pricing – Why 3 Prices?
Understanding that financial realities differ from family to family, Johnsonburg has instituted a voluntary three-tier fee program. You choose the tier that is most suitable for your situation. It is really a free will system; you tell us what is affordable for you and your family. All participants receive the same camp experience no matter what they pay! If Tier 3 presents a hardship to your family, additional financial assistance is available to ensure all children, youth, and adults have the opportunity to have an amazing camp experience. The Tiers
Tier 1- most closely reflects the true costs of camp, including year-round operations and wear and tear of facilities and grounds.
Tier 2- is a partially subsidized tier that more closely represents the true cost of camp relative to the basic tier fee.
Tier 3- is our historically subsidized rate and does not reflect the true cost of operating summer camp programs.

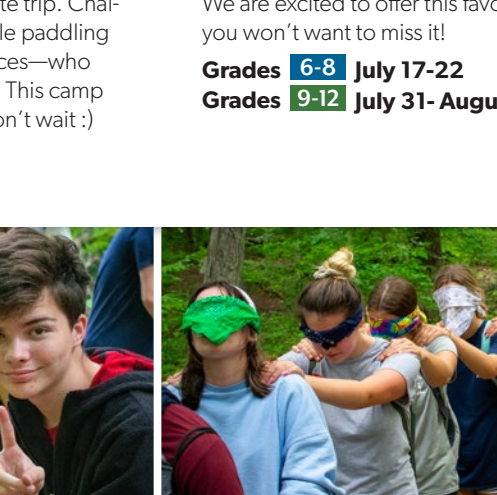
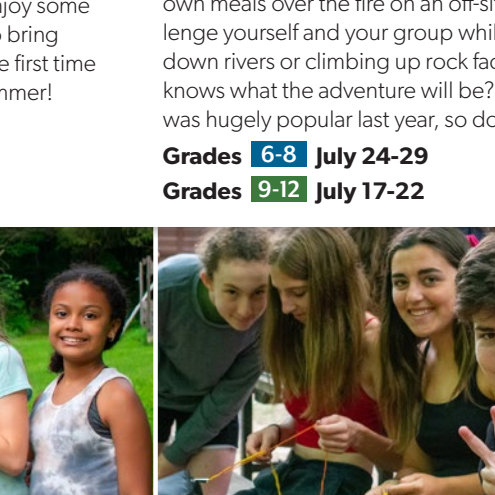
Night Owl Grades 6-8 & 9-12

CREW offers a final piece of Johnsonburg's leadership program. Created for a balance of camp fun and camp work, CREW members support our operations during the summer by helping out where needed. You also get to enjoy spending a week at camp with all it has to offer, including time at the waterfront, around a campfire, on high ropes, and all the other places and activities you love. The one-week fee for CREW in 2022 is \$50, which is just designed to defray very basic housing and meal costs; come for one week or the whole summer. *Completion of PLTP or LTP is not mandatory for entry into CREW.*

Staff

A well-trained, nurturing, and fun staff is the hallmark of our program. We hire a mature and diverse staff of youth development specialists through personal interview, references, and background checks. Staff receive two weeks of intensive training on group facilitation, positive behavior management, activity areas, outdoor living skills, and our bible study curriculum. Certified activity specialists, Red Cross certified lifeguards, a trained Health Officer and related medical professionals, work as a team with our counselors to care for each camper. We can't wait to share God's love with you and your family this summer.



Lodging

Cabins

Bunkbeds for 8-10 with electricity, private changing areas, and plenty of space for campers' belongings just a short walk from the bathroom. Shaded fire circles outside each cabin.

Tent Cabins (Tabins)

Large platforms with canvas tents and screen doors sleep 8-10. Located in the High Points, a beloved natural area of camp with a bathroom and campfire settings.

Lodges

Comfortable bedrooms sleep 3-5 with private bathrooms just steps away. The communal meeting area has a small kitchen too.

Hammocks

This optional lodging comes into play for our adventure groups and groups feeling adventurous. Sleep under the stars one night with rain protection and bug nets available. Summer camping at its finest!

**Please note:* in some cases lodging may be changed to best accommodate the program for the campers.
